Since these are safety related grants, they cover 100%. Upon completion of improvements, new tables, chairs and carpet to be purchased.

Solar Farm Discussion – Chief, along with PIO John Metzger, are working on completing a report to the County Commissioners by September 15th regarding fire and life safety concerns over the proposed solar farm.

Generator placement discussed. Dave Alexander said he can place the generator so it can be connected and placed in service.
