Call for Nominations:
Between 75 days and 100 days before a regular special district election, the designated election official shall provide notice by publication of a call for nominations for the election. The call must state the specific district director office to be voted upon at the election, where a self-nomination and acceptance form may be obtained, the deadline for submitting self-nomination and acceptance form or letter to the designated election official, and information on obtaining an absentee ballot. C.R.S. 1-13.5-501(2)
